A GfK Fairness Index, sponsored by GoodCorporation, carried out related research with 1,000 employees from a range of industries. It found that just under half of the employees surveyed thought their employer treats them fairly when it comes to issues such as internal communications, training, appraisals and work-life balance. Employees in the professional services industry had the least trust in their managers (39 per cent) while those who work in state education were found to have the highest level of trust in their managers (over 70 per cent).
