Case studies

Global construction company:

GoodCorporation undertook an eDiscovery project to review over 1TB of data equal to 15 million documents. The use of GoodCorporation's Logikcull eDiscovery platform allowed the task to be completed in four weeks. A benchmarking exercise was also carried out to compare the records of comprarable internal projects to evidence that failings were not systemic.

Operating in the Middle-East:

GoodCorporation provided investigation support with regard to allegations of supplier corruption. Twenty suppliers and 5,000 records were evaluated. Summary reports were provided for each of the 20 suppliers complete with a calculation of the percentage of any charging anomalies to assist in a meaningful analysis against comparable suppliers.
